3	AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PROVIDENCE CITY CODE 5-1-22(B) PUBLIC NUISANCES PROHIBITED
4	& 5-1-29 LOUD OR OFFENSIVE ANIMALS, PENALTY

WHEREAS UCA § 10-3-701 states, "except as otherwise specifically provided, the governing body of each municipality shall exercise its legislative power through ordinances." And

WHEREAS, Providence City has ordinances in place for the regulation and control of animals with the purpose of regulating, controlling, and protecting animals existing within Providence City, and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to comply with House Bill 202 (HB202) which changed animal control laws so as that "a municipality may not impose a criminal penalty greater than an infraction for a violation pertaining to an individual's pet...".

WHEREAS, PCC 5-1-22(B) AND 5-1-29: currently reads:

5-1-22(B) - A violation of this subsection shall be a <u>Class C misdemeanor</u>, subject to penalty as provided in Section 1-4-1 of this Code, and such is hereby declared to be a nuisance. Each day a violation is permitted to exist or continue, shall constitute a separate offense.

5-1-29 - No person shall own, keep, or harbor any dog which by loud, continued, or frequent barking, howling, yelping, or by noxious or offensive odors shall annoy, disturb, or endanger the health and welfare of any person or neighborhood. A violation of this subsection shall be a <u>Class C misdemeanor</u>, subject to penalty as provided in Section 1-4-1 of this Code, and such is hereby declared to be a nuisance, and each day a violation is permitted to exist or continue shall constitute a separate offense. The owner of a dog or dogs found in violation of the provisions of this section 5.1 on five (5) or more separate occasions may be required by the court to permanently remove the dog or dogs from the premises. This subsection shall not apply to the City pound, veterinary hospitals, or medical laboratories.

WHEREAS, City staff recommends per HB202 the following amendments:

5-1-22(B) - A violation of this subsection shall be a Class C misdemeanor infraction, subject to penalty as provided in Section 1-4-1 of this Code, and such is hereby declared to be a nuisance. Each day a violation is permitted to exist or continue, shall constitute a separate offense.

5-1-29 - No person shall own, keep, or harbor any dog which by loud, continued, or frequent barking, howling, yelping, or by noxious or offensive odors shall annoy, disturb, or endanger the health and welfare of any person or neighborhood. A violation of this subsection shall be a Class C misdemeanor, infraction, subject to penalty as provided in Section 1-4-1 of this Code, and such is hereby declared to be a nuisance, and each day a violation is permitted to exist or continue shall constitute a separate offense. The owner of a dog or dogs found in violation of the provisions of this section 5.1 on five (5) or more
