**Providence Sauerkraut**

- Homemade Sauerkraut is Back!
- A group of community volunteers are working on bringing back the Pioneer tradition of making Providence produced sauerkraut. You may recall that 8 years ago, State of Utah health inspectors shut down the operation. We are pleased to have the assistance of Dr. Brian Nummer, USU Assistant Professor in the Nutrition and Food Sciences department (and a Providence resident) to make sure we meet all Bear River Heath, Utah State and FDA requirements to make this happen in a clean and sanitary manner that meets all regulatory requirements.
- We have two local growers with about 1400 head of cabbage being produced this summer. We will have canned (glass jars) sauerkraut for sale in quart and pint jars as well as our local sauerkraut being served at the Sauerkraut Dinner scheduled for Friday evening, October 11<sup>th</sup>.
- We Need Volunteers!
- *Process Cabbage* – We need some muscled individuals to help quarter, core, salt and tamp the cabbage. This process will be at the cafeteria kitchen at Providence Elementary. Football player sized young folk are encouraged to help out; and invite your fellow teammates. We need about two dozen volunteers, in two shifts of 12 each for Saturday, September 7<sup>th</sup>.

- *Can Sauerkraut* – The canning will be done at USU Food Sciences and Nutrition building where the finished product will be put in glass jars, hot water bath processed, cooled, and then labeled and boxed. We will need sixteen volunteers, in two shifts of 8 each planned for Saturday, September 27<sup>th</sup>.
- *Label for Glass Jars* - We are looking for artwork that can be used for the label for the quart and pint glass jars.
- *Sauerkraut Dinner* – The dinner will be on Friday, October 11<sup>th</sup> at the Old Rock Church from 5 to 9 PM. We will need volunteers to help serve, clean up, set up tables and chairs; about 20 people.
