

Ordinance No. 002-2013

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PROVIDENCE CITY CODE TITLE 3 BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS CHAPTER 1 GENERAL LICENSE PROVISIONS AMENDING THE PAYMENT DATES AND LATE PENALTIES.

WHEREAS UCA § 10-3-702 states: "the governing body may pass any ordinance to regulate, require, prohibit, govern, control or supervise any activity, business, conduct or condition authorized by this act or any other provision of law."

WHEREAS Providence City desires to clarify the business license payment dates and penalty for late payment as follows:

3-1-7: PAYMENT DATES: All license fees, except Residential Solicitation license fees, shall be due and payable as follows, except as may be otherwise provided:

- A. Payable: Annual fees shall be payable before each calendar year, in advance. The annual license shall date from January 1 of each year and shall expire on December 31 of each year. All businesses will may be notified thirty (30) days before expiration (December 1) by a business license billing statement. (OM004-99 02/23/99). Annual fees may not be paid more than 60 days prior to the expiration date.
B. Due: Annual fees shall be due on January 1 of each calendar year and shall become delinquent if not paid by prior to February 1 of each year. If the annual fee is paid prior to expiration (December 31), the home-business fee shall be reduced by 10% \$5.00; the commercial business fee shall be reduced by \$10.00.
C. Penalty for Late Payment: If any license fee is not paid within thirty (30) days of the due date by January 31, a penalty of one hundred fifty percent (100 50%) of the amount of such license fee shall be added to the original amount thereof. If a license fee is not paid within sixty (60) days of the original due date by the last day of February, the total license fees due at the time shall be doubled. If any license fee is not paid within ninety (90) days of the original due date by March 31, a new application must be filed with the application fee and any and all late fees. The business license will be subject to all City, state, and/or federal codes and any other applicable rules and regulations in effect as of the date the new application is filed.

THEREFORE be it ordained by the Providence City Council

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and posting.
