18 **Business Items:**

19 Item No. 1. Bell Monument: The HPC will discuss the Providence Elementary Bell Monument.

- 20 • Kent Craven, Design West Architects, discussed donating time and materials for the
21 monument with the commission. He said the contractor should be done by mid-May so
22 the monument should be done by that time.
- 23 • C McGrath asked him to design a few ideas. She said there is some budget for the
24 monument if required.
- 25 • H Christenson suggested Al's Framing make the bronze plaque.
- 26 • The commission would like to have a picture of the old school included in the
27 monument.
- 28 • H Christenson suggested making the monument about more than just the bell tower. He
29 felt the history of the school was important to be included.
- 30 • S Flammer said the ringing of the bell was also a big part of the experience for the
31 school children.
- 32 • C McGrath asked each commissioner to find out what they can about the history of the
33 school, who built it, teachers, etc.

35 Item No. 2. CLG Grant Revision. The HPC will discuss revisions to the CLG Grant.

- 36 • A portion of the CLG Grant request was denied. Skarlet will call Cory to see how long
37 they will extend the application timeframe.
- 38 • C McGrath would like to do two more intensive level surveys. Some of the houses on
39 Main Street were discussed as possibilities. The old Theurer home was suggested.
- 40 • S Bankhead suggested the old Bishop's storehouse, but wasn't sure if an intensive level
41 survey had been done on that home or not.
- 42 • The home at 153 S. Main was also suggested for an intensive level survey.
- 43 • S Bankhead also suggested the property that was the Big Spring where the early settlers
44 camped when they first came to the valley as a possible intensive level survey, but
45 wasn't sure if it would qualify.
- 46 • C McGrath will check with Cory to see which of these suggestions qualify.


