Administration Items of Interest:

Notice of Election.

Providence City will hold a municipal general election on Tuesday, November 5, 2013 to elect the mayor and two city council members.

- Candidates for Mayor: Don W. Calderwood, Ronald S. Liechty
- Candidates for Council: Steve Liechty, John Drew, Jeff Baldwin
- All Providence Precincts will vote at the LDS Church building located at 420 West 100 North

Gardeners Market:

- We have someone who has volunteered to serve as chairman for a Gardeners Market Committee. If you would like to help on this committee, please contact the City Office.

Business Alliance:

- Providence City would like to have more communication with businesses and business owners in the City. Forming a business alliance has been suggested. If you would like to help with this project, or if you have suggestions you would like considered, please contact the City Office.

Business Licenses:

- Business licenses are due January 1, 2014. Please renew your business license early to avoid late penalties. Business licenses renewed prior to December 31, 2013 are reduced by 10%.

Dog License:

- Dog license renewals will begin December 2. Dog licenses are due January 1 and are considered delinquent February 1. Please make sure you have a current rabies tag or certificate. We cannot issue a dog license, if your dog's rabies shot has expired. If you no longer own a dog, or if the number of dogs you own has changed during the year, please contact the City Office so we can update our records.

Outdoor Pets:

- As the temperature drops and winter overtakes autumn, we encourage you to remember the needs of your outdoor pets. Please make sure they have food, water, and a warm shelter; not only for the safety of the pets, but so they don't seek shelter at the neighbors.

Thank you:

- During this month of Thanksgiving, we would like to express thanks to all those that have helped with the various events and activities sponsored by the City. We would also like to thank you, the citizens of Providence, for your patience during our construction projects, supporting our events and activities, and being good neighbors.

Public Works Items of Interest:

Leaves:

- Providence City will be picking up leaves. Please put your leaves in bags and place the bags on the parkstrip for pick up. Please help us keep the gutters and ditches clean and free of leaves. Thank you in advance for your help keeping the leaves and bags out of the gutters and ditches.

Winter Parking Hours:

Night Parking: It shall be unlawful for the driver or owner of any vehicle to park any vehicle or equipment on any street or right of way within eight feet (8') of the pavement in the City beginning 24 hours after the first measurable snowfall (enough to require City snow removal, which occurs after October 31); or December 1, whichever comes earlier, of each year and ending April 15 of the following year, between the hours of twelve o'clock (12:00) midnight and six o'clock (6:00) A.M. the next day, for a period of time longer than three (3) minutes when loading or unloading passengers. This

subsection shall not apply to doctors on house calls, emergency vehicles, or vehicles used in the repair of utilities.

The City will not be liable for any damage occurring to any vehicle or equipment parked on any street or right of way, during street and right of way maintenance.
