Our Sauerkraut Days parade is an event to bring our community together, showcase those involved in our community and provide entertainment! We hope you are excited to participate. We request that all participants apply and participate with this goal in mind. Be creative, decorate a float, a car, march in costume with the intent to entertain. All applications will be reviewed and approved by our Sauerkraut Days Committee.

The parade route will run north on Main street to Center street, concluding at Zollinger Park. The parade will begin at 5pm. You will receive specific staging instructions as your application is accepted. We ask that no participants stop along the route to distribute handouts or give any kind of performance. Safety is our highest priority. Unsafe or reckless operation of vehicles will not be tolerated. Participants who plan to distribute candy and or other giveaways must assign someone to walk the parade route in order to safely distribute items to spectators. Participants are not allowed to hang off the sides of moving vehicles. Please keep your position in the parade with your assigned parade marshal.

In lieu of an entry fee we request a volunteer to help with parade set up or clean up.

Applications should be completed, and signed by participant representative and received by 5pm August 1st, 2022.
