

## Crosswalks, Safety, and Fundraiser

As school will begin this month, we ask that drivers pay close attention to crosswalks and obey all traffic safety laws. Remember that it is illegal to move your vehicle across a school zone crosswalk until the walkway is ***completely clear*** of both crossing guards and pedestrians. Additionally, we encourage the use of safety crossing flags where available and invite you to review and use Safe Routes Maps by using the QR code or visiting: <https://saferoutes.utah.gov/>.



Last school year we had a crossing guard get clipped by a hit and run vehicle as well as some narrow escapes. The Cache County Sheriff's office has suggested body cameras have been a very effective way to identify traffic offenders putting our children and crossing guards at risk.

As a result, a citizen fundraiser has been established. The goal is to raise \$4,000.00 which will be used to purchase ten body cameras. This equipment will be given to Providence City and worn by the crossing guards. Please help keep everyone safe by contributing! During Sauerkraut Days a contribution container will be at the Old Rock Church, Providence City offices, and Zollinger Park.
